The former Oasis Corp. site, which sat empty for 10 years, is being redeveloped into a state-of-the-art, 140,000 s.f. Class A manufacturing and distribution facility.







In 2014, the City IT Department installed new, lower-cost technology in police and fire vehicles, new zoning software in the Building Department, a system to record City Council meetings and tested collaborative police dispatching, among other programs.





22 homeowners were assisted with exterior home remodeling projects, thanks to the 2014 Home Reinvestment Program. Residents' projects account for more than a **\$200,000** investment in the community.



After relocating part of its operations to Whitehall, Rite Rug chose the City to be its new corporate HQ.

Thousands of central Ohioans attended the City's premier events - the Whitehall Food Truck & Fun Festival, the Whitehall Senior Health & Safety Expo and more.



EMS & Fire Runs

Fire and EMS runs in 2014 increased more than 8% compared to 2013. The top reasons for EMS runs were illness (1,256 runs) and **injury** (813 runs).






WHITEHALL IS LOCATED WITHIN 10 HOURS OF NEARLY 50 PERCENT OF THE U.S. POPULATION
