

Hiring Standards

- Must be a United States Citizen
- Must have graduated high school or have a GED
- Must have a valid Ohio State Driver's License
- Must be able to fluently speak, read, and write using the English language
- Must have eyesight correctable to 20/20 in both eyes
- Must be able to pass a physical exam and testing procedures as established by NFPA and the Ohio Police and Fire Pension System
- Must possess a State of Ohio Firefighter II certification (or be able to show proof of the ability to obtain the certification by date of appointment to the Division of Fire)
- Must possess a State of Ohio Paramedic certification (or be able to show proof of the ability to obtain the certification by date of appointment to the Division of Fire)

Disqualifiers

During the hiring process, if it is discovered that a candidate has any of the following items identified, they will be removed from the hiring process:

- Conviction of any felony or criminal misdemeanor
- A license revocation, multiple convictions of OMVI, a twelve point suspension and/or multiple moving violations within a twelve month period
- Any pattern of use of illegal drugs or a pattern of drug abuse
- Any abuse of solvent-based chemicals and/or non-recovered use or abuse of alcohol
- Poor employment history
- Poor credit history, a history of financial problems, wage garnishments, bankruptcy, poor payment records, may disqualify a candidate from consideration
